**Stop the relentless persecution and

Dear Prime Minister Trudeau,

I am shocked that France is putting Dr. Hassan Diab on trial for a crime he clearly did not commit.

In 2018, after Hassan had languished over three years in prison in France, two French investigative judges dismissed all allegations against Hassan and freed him unconditionally in the face of overwhelming evidence of his innocence.

You publicly stated at the time: **“I think, for Hassan Diab, we have to recognise first of all that what happened to him never should have happened... and make sure that it never happens again.”**

I urge you to honour your words by protecting Hassan, stopping the relentless persecution, and refusing any future extradition request from France.
